Pratt is the founder and Director of Training Transformational Teachers (TTT), one of the only full-semester Neuroeducation programs for college professors in the United States. He has decades of experience as a college professor, change agent, and coach of business and education leaders from around the world. He blends that experience with his training as an accredited coach with the Neuroleadership Institute to share insights from the most relevant research on how people learn, access what they've learned, and figure out how to apply it.

Pratt is a faculty member at the Berklee College of Music, where he won the Dean's Award for Innovation & Service for his creation of TTT and his work in helping teachers from Berklee, Emerson College, the Boston Architectural College, The School of the Museum of Fine Arts, the Mass College of Art, and the Boston Conservatory develop brain-based teaching tools that engage more of their students and challenge them to become more self-directed learners. He has presented his training at many conferences and will be the keynote speaker at the Eastern Communication Association Conference in March, 2017.

Drawing from his 30 years of working with nearly 20,000 students and business leaders from the U.S., Canada, and 94 other countries, Pratt shares his deep understanding of what the most common barriers to communication and mutual understanding are and how to overcome them to pursue shared goals. His programs guide members from information to implementation and include monthly group coaching sessions that inspire members to think outside the limitations of their respective disciplines and achieve breakthroughs in communication and group leadership.
